NPQ SENCo

NEW QUALIFICATION FOR SENCOs COMING - SEPTEMBER 2024

We are excited to be involved with various providers on the delivery of the NPQ SENCo and would recommend that you get in touch with your local provider to register your interest. All providers will be offering it slightly differently.

In many places, students with SEND don't progress as well as their peers. A great SENCo can help these students thrive socially and academically. SENCo's play a crucial role in UK schools by providing tailored support for students with SEND and by promoting teaching methods, curriculum, and behaviour strategies that benefit all students.

The new NPQ for SENCOs prepares you for this important role in any school setting. You'll learn about the legal aspects of the role and how to improve practices across the entire school to help all students, including those with SEND, succeed. Throughout the qualification, experienced SENCOs will guide you to develop the skills and approaches needed to lead in this area effectively.

Who is it for?

The NPQ for SENCOs is required for both current and aspiring SENCOs. They must complete this qualification within their first three years in the role. Note that SENCOs who already have the NASENCO qualification or were appointed before September 1, 2009, are exempt from this requirement.

What you'll learn:

- How to create a culture of high expectations and achievement for all students
- Understanding and implementing the legal framework and compliance requirements of the SENCO role
- Effectively deploying staff and resources to support individual students in overcoming barriers
- Monitoring student progress and adjusting plans in collaboration with stakeholders
- Supporting teachers and leaders in developing and adapting lessons for all students' needs
- Motivating students with SEND and ensuring they feel supported by the school's culture
- Leading, monitoring, and reviewing the school's provision and practices for students with SEND

SEND Leadership Training

A TIERED APPROACH

Our tiered training program helps school leaders understand their responsibilities in SEND leadership. It covers statutory requirements, delegation, curriculum adaptation, and provision monitoring, ensuring leaders are clear on their roles and supporting their teams effectively.

- **Tier 1: Leadership** - Training for senior school leaders on strategic SEND leadership, including delegation schemes and provision audits focusing on leadership, teaching quality, and resource use.
- **Tier 2: SENCo's** - Tailored for SENCos to lead strategically, partnering with senior teams for school-wide training. Linking theory with practice for future-proofing inclusive education.
- **Tier 3: Middle Leaders** - Ensures a clear grasp of SEND statutory requirements, facilitating curriculum reviews for inclusivity. Guides MLs in supporting teachers and monitoring effectiveness.
- **Tier 4: Teachers** - A modular toolkit accessible to all Teachers based on their CPD needs. Complementing ECT and NPQ packages, the twelve modules are 1.5-hour webinars.
