CIT - Ofsted Hat-trick



The Community Inclusive Trust are delighted to report that three of our schools have been graded 'Good' by Ofsted in recent inspections.

Isaac Newton Primary School in Grantham was inspected on 11th and 12th February 2025, the school has been graded 'Good' in all areas, with 'Outstanding' in behaviour.

Ofsted reported: "There is a wonderful climate of ambition, kindness and care at this school. Because of this, pupils behave and achieve extremely well. They are committed to their school and keen to learn. Lessons are calm. Routines are well understood. Pupils show each other respect. They are an absolute credit to the school and to the community."

The inspector also commented that highly effective safeguarding arrangements are in place and pupils' welfare is top of everyone's list: "The school is a fierce advocate for pupils and their families. Skilled and knowledgeable staff work relentlessly to address the barriers to learning that some pupils face. Pupils are helped to leave adversity at the school door, to feel safe and to learn."

Caythorpe Primary School based just outside of Grantham, was inspected on 10th and 11th December 2024, the school was graded 'Good' in all areas.

The report stated, 'Caythorpe Primary is a warm and welcoming school that is treasured by pupils and their families. Pupils feel happy and safe. They rightly describe the school as inclusive and caring. The school has high expectations of pupils' behaviour and achievement... their good behaviour positively contributes to their learning. Routines are well understood, including within the early years.'

The report also noted, 'parents and carers are extremely positive about the school. They express gratitude for the work of the school and the impact this work has on their child.'

Caythorpe was praised for its support of pupils with SEND. 'Pupils with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) receive expert support. The school ensures that their needs are quickly identified and addressed. The curriculum is suitably adapted so that pupils successfully take part in all lessons. Pupils with SEND flourish in the school and achieve well.'

Boston Endeavour Academy was inspected on 3rd and 4th of December 2024, the school was graded 'Good'.

Ofsted reported: 'Boston Endeavour Academy is an inclusive, happy and welcoming school. All pupils at the school have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND). They face significant difficulties and challenges in their learning and development. Staff work hard to meet the health, education and care needs of pupils while also ensuring pupils enjoy their time at school. Staff make sure that all pupils receive the high-quality care and respect that they deserve. All pupils, including those with the most complex difficulties, have positive relationships with staff. Pupils are happy at school because the staff look after them so well.'

A huge well done to the staffing teams across all three schools!
